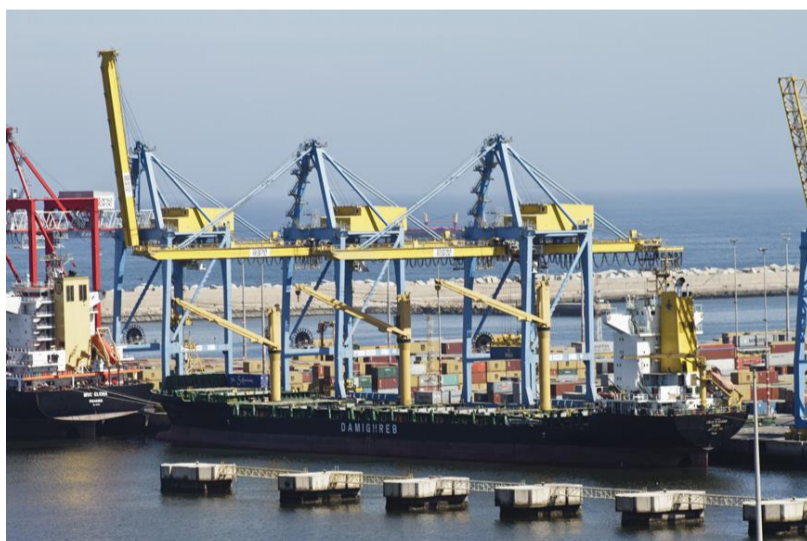


## BEST REGIONAL MARITIME PORT

# PORT OF CASABLANCA



**The Best Regional Maritime Port's Label for Excellence has been presented to the Port of Casablanca represented by Mr. Moha Hamaoui, Director of Ports, Ministry of Transport, during a Ceremony in Brussels on March 21, 2014.**



The Port of Casablanca has been built between 1913 and 1917. It is located in the center of the Atlantic coast of Morocco at the bottom of a sheltered little bay. The port is connected to the boulevard Ben Aïchaat the east and to the boulevard des Almohads at the west.

Largest port in Morocco during years, it is multifunction, but mostly focused on trade. It extends over 450 ha and can accommodate up to 40 ships a day. It includes a commercial port, a fishing port, a marina, as well as facilities and infrastructure for setting afloat and dry vessels in shipyards.

Casablanca's port treats a traffic of more than 21,3 million tons per annum, that is to say 38% of the national traffic, and carries out a sales turnover of more than 894 Million Moroccan Dirhams. With an extent of 605 hectares and extending to more than 8 kilometers in length.
